ADMISSIONS

Tyrannus Hall Diphu – A Leadership Residency for Committed Christian Students

Tyrannus Hall is primarily a residential leadership program focused on **Christian discipleship**. It is **not intended simply to solve accommodation needs**. Therefore, admissions are open to students who:

- Are professing Christians,
 - Have made a **personal commitment to follow Jesus Christ**, and
 - Desire to **grow in their faith** and serve Christ and His Church in whatever profession they are called to.
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Eligibility Criteria

1. **Priority Representation**
A sincere and intentional effort will be made to ensure **fair representation from all Karbi Anglong Baptist Convention (KABC)** member associations and churches.
2. **Interdenominational Unity**
To promote Christian fellowship across denominations, **5% of the seats may be reserved** for students from Christian groups outside the KABC.
3. **Academic Status**
Only full-time students enrolled in **Higher Secondary, Bachelor's, or Master's** programs are eligible to apply.
4. **Agreement to Community Standards**
Applicants must **read, understand, and agree to abide by the hostel rules and regulations** as a prerequisite for admission.

5. Interview & Selection

All applicants will be interviewed by the **Local Management Board**, which holds the **final authority** on selection and admission decisions.

6. Re-Admission Policy

Admission is granted **on an annual basis**. All students must **reapply for admission** each academic year. Readmission is not guaranteed and is subject to the discretion of the board.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must submit the following documents:

- **Character Certificate**
From the head of the applicant's previous school/institution and from the **Pastor of their local church**. (If transferring from another hostel, a **letter from the hostel superintendent** is also required.)
 - **Medical Fitness Certificate**
Issued by a **recognized medical officer**.
 - **Academic Record**
A **self-attested copy** of the marksheet from the most recent final examination.
 - **Photographs**
Two **recent passport-sized photographs**.
